

## MIT-Germany - FAU Seed Fund

Launched in 2018, the fund provides faculty and research scientists at MIT and the Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg (FAU) the opportunity to jointly apply for seed grants. The maximum award is \$35,000.

Open to all disciplines, priority will be given to projects that:

- propose a balanced exchange between MIT and FAU participants
- involve students in the project
- demonstrate complementarity between the teams

The MIT-Germany FAU Seed Fund is a part of MISTI Global Seed Funds. All general MISTI Global Seed Funds criteria, application and evaluation procedures apply. This year's application deadline is December 14th, 2020.
